- Utilize virtual meeting tools to engage members and guests from anywhere and demonstrate effective use practices
  - Create a NLCVA Google Circle which will allow us to use Google Hangout; invite everyone to be a part of the circle
  - Experiment with Zoom
- Support an exchange program with faculty, administrators and professionals across member campuses-- Andrea will look at this

    - Ask member institutions to host others for a specific topic or just for general observation (and members can ask to visit other institutions)

- Organizational Structure
